House Sends Landmark National Service Bill to President	Via on-line	March 31 st , 75 years to the day after President Roosevelt signed the Civilian Conservation Corps into law, the House of Representatives today sent President Obama a sweeping expansion of national service that will engage millions of Americans in meeting national needs and solving local problems through volunteer service. The House voted 275-149 to accept the Senate amendments to H.R. 1388, the Edward M. Kennedy Serve America Act. The Senate passed the bill in a 79-19 vote and renamed the legislation after Senator Kennedy, a longtime champion of national service. House sends Landmark National Service Bill to President. This bill has been signed into law.

Coalition on Human Needs on Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention Act!	Via on-line	Support of S. 678, the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDP) Reauthorization Bill. The Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act is a major vehicle for juvenile justice reform at the federal level. The JJDP was first passed in 1974 and most recently reauthorized in 2002. It provides grants to states to assist with juvenile crime prevention and intervention programs. In order to be eligible for these grants, states must comply with the four core protections to ensure that status offenders are not detained, to remove children from placement in adult jails except in limited circumstances, and in those limited circumstances to ensure sight and sound separation from adults, and to reduce the over-representation of youth of color in the justice system.
